 - Coordination of Services for Expelled Students -Priority 9
 - Coordination of Services for Foster Youth Priority

Local Indicator Ratings

- » 3 Ratings (not Performance Levels)
 - Data Reported
 - Used self-reflection tool to evaluate progress on local indicator
 - Reported results from self-reflection tool at regularly scheduled governing board meeting and on Dashboard
 - Not Met or Not Met?
 Data Not Reported or Data Not Reported for Two or More Years
- » Self-reflection tool results don't impact rating



Displaying Ratings

- » Ratings for 4 Local Indicators will be <u>displayed</u> for school districts and charter schools
 - Local indicator only <u>applies</u> to charter school for purposes of Technical Assistance if priority is included in underlying charter petition
- » Ratings for 6 Local Indicators will be <u>displayed</u> for county offices of education
- » No Local Indicators will be <u>displayed</u> for individual school sites





- » LEA Dashboard Coordinators will be able to upload information for each local indicator
- » No upload required for this year
 - If nothing is uploaded, rating will be "N/A"
 - LEAs are strongly encouraged to upload and use Local Indicator data this year

» Basics

- Report, for each school site, on # and % of
 - Teacher misassignments of ELs, total teacher misassignments, and vacant teacher positions
 - Students w/o access to own copies of standards-aligned instructional materials for use at school and at home
 - Instances of facilities not in "good repair"
- Data will be auto-populated for LEAs using CDE's online SARC template





» Local Climate Survey

- Summarize administration and analysis of survey capturing <u>valid measure</u> of student perceptions of safety and connectedness in at least one grade within each grade span served by LEA
 - Summary may include, as applicable, overall scores for all students and each student groups
 - Summary may also include analysis of specific survey items that are particularly relevant to school safety and connectedness



Local Climate Survey

- » How might your LEA think about gathering valid and reliable school climate data?
- » What might be some challenges?
- » How might Local Climate Survey be reflected in LCAP goals?





- » Implementation of Academic Standards
 - Complete optional reflection tool included in Dashboard

OR

- Summarize <u>progress in implementation of state</u> <u>academic standards</u> based on locally selected measures or tools
 - Summary must identify measures/tools used to track progress and describe why they were chosen





- » Parent (Family) Engagement
 - Summarize progress in (i) <u>seeking input from</u> <u>parents/guardians in local decision making</u> (ii) <u>promoting parental participation in programs</u>
 - Summary must be based on either surveys or other local measures
 - Summary must describe why surveys and/or other local measures were chosen, including whether progress is related to other (non-parent engagement) LCAP goals





- » What might your LEA want to learn?
- » What data might your LEA collect?
 - How to collect data for the local indicator?
 - How to interpret data collected for the local indicator?
