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The CCEE ‘Demystifying the Dashboard’ to Help Empower School Communities

State agency offering virtual and in-person CA School Dashboard trainings in 2018

With the release of Fall 2017 California School Dashboard data, many educators, families and education advocates are trying to make sense of the system’s performance metrics and how they can use the data to improve student learning at local schools.

The reality is many districts and schools need help to demystify the Dashboard results for their local school communities and are looking for support.

[The California Collaborative for Education Excellence \(CCEE\)](#) is stepping-up its efforts to offer that assistance in 2018 by offering large-scale and customized Dashboard trainings both online and in-person.

The next training on **Thursday, February 8**, is called “*Build Your Dashboard Data Literacy*.” This free training will be live streamed via a webinar and is tailored for educators who want a deep dive into complex Dashboard data so they can make school improvement decisions that are research-based, equity focused, and informed by stakeholder engagement.
