- » Basics (Teacher Assignments, Instructional Materials, Facilities) - Priority 1
- » Implementation of Academic Standards - Priority 2
- » Parent Engagement - Priority 3
- » Local Climate Survey - Priority 6



Local Indicators

- » County offices have two additional local indicators
 - Coordination of Services for Expelled Students - Priority 9
 - Coordination of Services for Foster Youth - Priority 10

Local Indicator Ratings

» 3 Ratings (not Performance Levels)

Met?

- ~~Data Reported~~

- Used self-reflection tool to evaluate progress on local indicator
- Reported results from self-reflection tool at regularly scheduled governing board meeting and on Dashboard

Not Met or Not Met?

- ~~Data Not Reported or Data Not Reported for Two or More Years~~

» Self-reflection tool results don't impact rating

Displaying Ratings

- » Ratings for 4 Local Indicators will be displayed for school districts and charter schools
 - Local indicator only applies to charter school for purposes of Technical Assistance if priority is included in underlying charter petition
- » Ratings for 6 Local Indicators will be displayed for county offices of education
- » No Local Indicators will be displayed for individual school sites



Reporting Rating

- » LEA Dashboard Coordinators will be able to upload information for each local indicator
- » **No upload required for this year**
 - If nothing is uploaded, rating will be “N/A”
 - LEAs are strongly encouraged to upload and use Local Indicator data this year

Reporting Rating

- » Beginning in 2017–18, there will be a date (currently scheduled for Fall) when LEAs must complete Self-Reflection tool in order to receive rating
 - If nothing is uploaded, rating will be “~~Data Not Reported~~” or “~~Data Not Reported~~ for Two or More Years” as appropriate

Self-Reflection Tool



» Basics

- Report, for each school site, on # and % of
 - Teacher misassignments of ELs, total teacher misassignments, and vacant teacher positions
 - Students w/o access to own copies of standards-aligned instructional materials for use at school and at home
 - Instances of facilities not in “good repair”
- Data will be auto-populated for LEAs using CDE’s online SARC template

Self-Reflection Tool



» Local Climate Survey

- Summarize administration and analysis of survey capturing valid measure of student perceptions of safety and connectedness in at least one grade within each grade span served by LEA
 - Summary may include, as applicable, overall scores for all students and each student groups
 - Summary may also include analysis of specific survey items that are particularly relevant to school safety and connectedness



Local Climate Survey

- » How might your LEA think about gathering valid and reliable school climate data?
- » What might be some challenges?
- » How might Local Climate Survey be reflected in LCAP goals?

Self-Reflection Tool

» Implementation of Academic Standards

- Complete optional reflection tool included in Dashboard

OR

- Summarize progress in implementation of state academic standards based on locally selected measures or tools
 - Summary must identify measures/tools used to track progress and describe why they were chosen

Self-Reflection Tool



» Parent (Family) Engagement

- Summarize progress in (i) seeking input from parents/guardians in local decision making (ii) promoting parental participation in programs
 - Summary must be based on either surveys or other local measures
 - Summary must describe why surveys and/or other local measures were chosen, including whether progress is related to other (non-parent engagement) LCAP goals

Planning

- » What might your LEA want to learn?
- » What data might your LEA collect?
 - How to collect data for the local indicator?
 - How to interpret data collected for the local indicator?

Planning

- » How might these data be used to make decisions?
- » How might your LEA communicate throughout the process with stakeholders?
- » Who might need to be included in these discussions/decisions?
