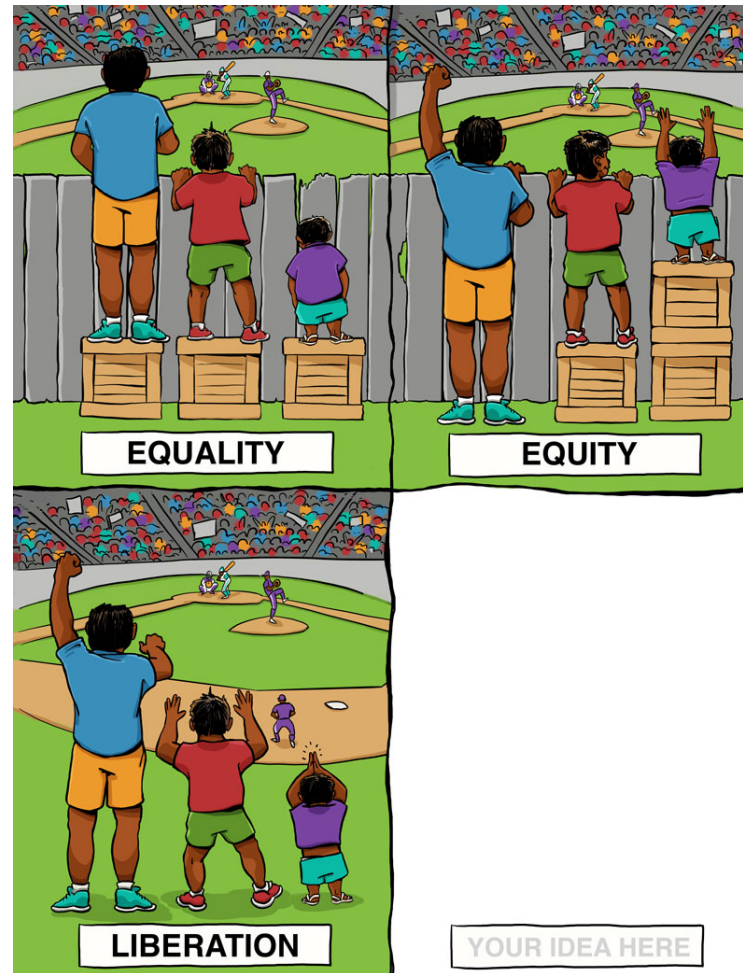
Student and Staff Safety

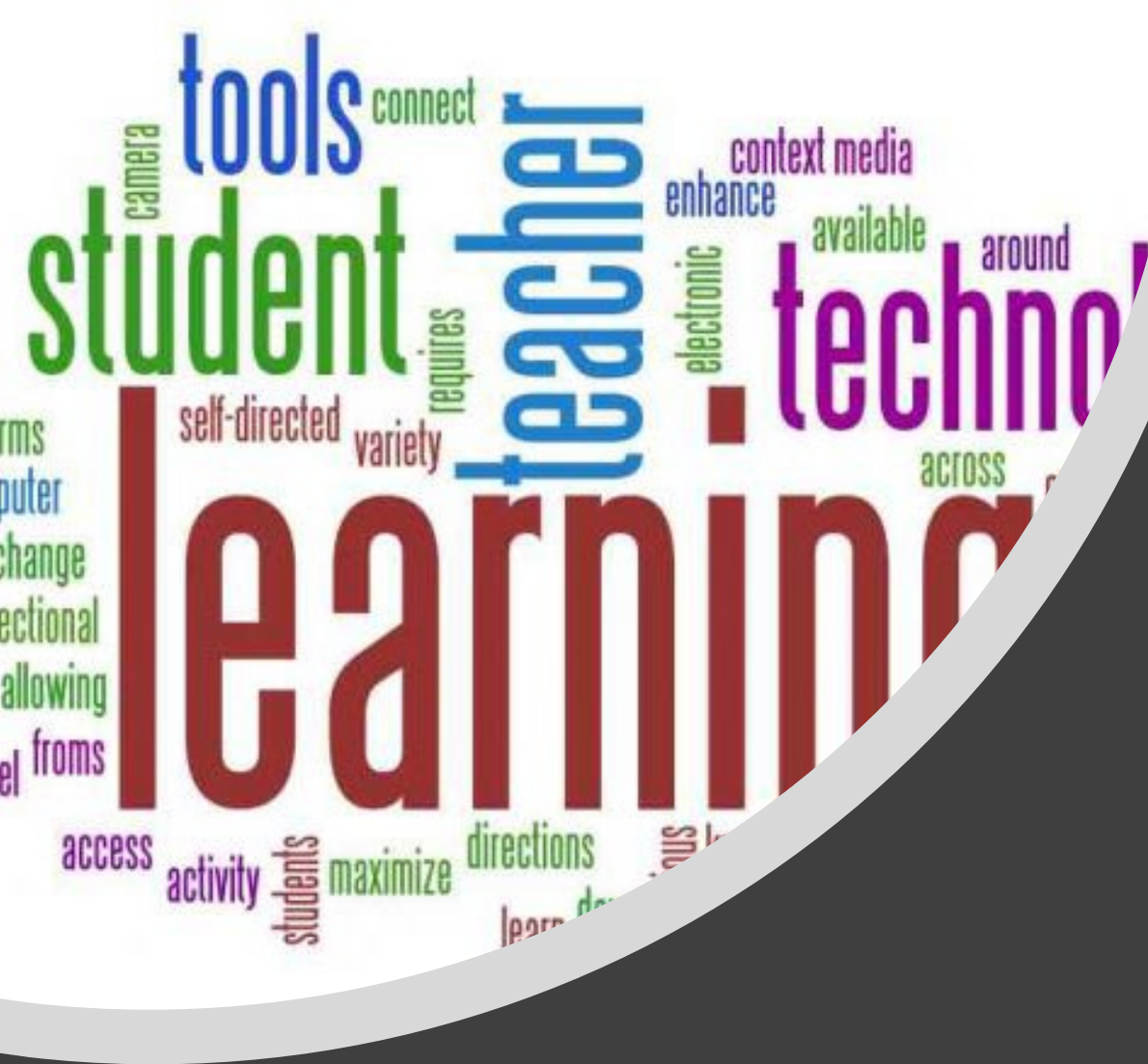
- Guidance from the Alameda County Public Health Department & the Center for Disease Control



- Practicing Mitigation Strategies
 - Stay Home When Sick
 - Physical Distancing (no more than 10-13 students per class)

 - Wear a Mask
 - Disinfecting Frequently Used Surfaces
 - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

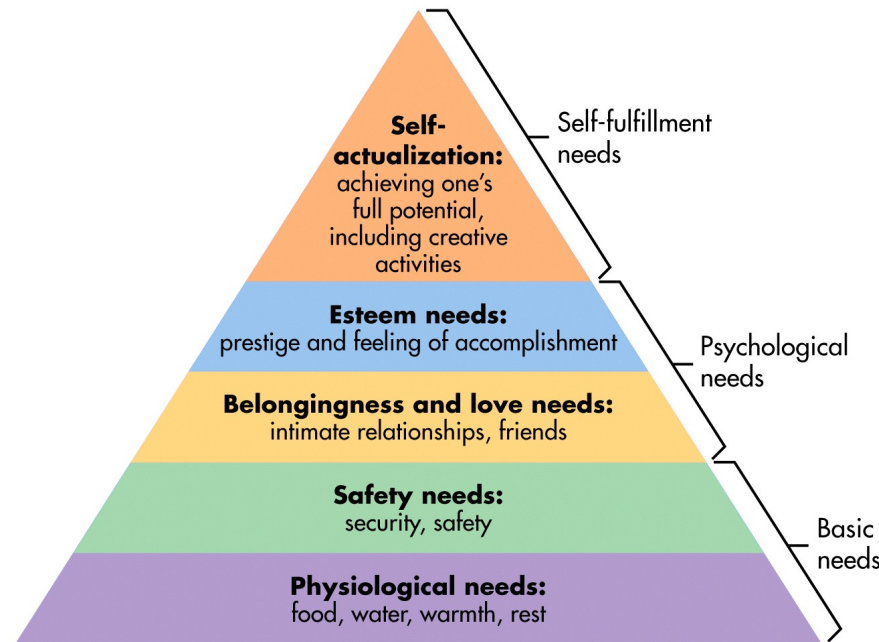
