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Setting the Context

On March 5, 2021, Governor Gavin Newsom signed <u>Assembly Bill 86</u>, which requires every school district, county office of education, charter school and private school to submit the following information <u>by school site and district</u>:

- Student enrollment
- Number of students in:
 - Full-time in-person instruction
 - Hybrid instruction
 - Distance learning only
- Number of students being served in cohorts and services they're receiving





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- For LEAs not offering in-person instruction:
 - Reasons why in-person instruction is not being offered
 - Barriers in providing in-person instruction
- Number of employees working on-site
