






CCEE New Organizational Structures

Problem we solve: Directly improve teaching and learning.

How: Direct support to leadership teams on system transformation for teaching and learning.


Why different: This team works in direct partnership with schools/districts/county offices to support school improvement.

Problem we solve: Improve statewide access to research and strategies that improve student outcomes

How: Professional learning resources, networks, and dissemination support

Why different: 13 builds capacity indirectly by linking the development and vetting of resources/learning with dissemination to increase access.


Center Goals



Problem we solve: Integration across state, counties and districts for a common goal of a coherent statewide system of support.

How: Create shared vision, coherence and alignment through partnership development, collaborative convenings, and facilitation, also need and ability to pivot to meet needs of field.

Why different: Developing coherence and alignment of systems



Goal: Build capacity and support for local educational agency (LEAs) currently receiving and in need of targeted assistance to effectively address the systemic and instructional needs of students historically underserved.

Initiative 1

Advise and assist County Offices of Education (COEs) & LEAs in need of targeted assistance in achieving their LCAP goals by effectively meeting the needs of students historically underserved.

Provide direct technical assistance (DTA) to COEs/LEAs to address systemic performance of disadvantaged student groups as measured in the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and Statewide Dashboard

Initiative 2

Identify and use school/district turnaround principles that effectively build capacity of (LEAs) in Direct Technical Assistance (DTA) to address the academic and social emotional well-being of all students


Implement, share, and use school and district turnaround principles in targeted assistance to address both district and classroom teaching and learning frameworks

Initiative 3

Build a statewide professional learning infrastructure focused on learning acceleration through Evidence-Based Practices (EBPs) in Literacy, Mathematics, and Language Development

In partnerships with (a) selected COE(s), establish a statewide professional development infrastructure to expand the use of evidence based accelerated learning strategies in literacy, mathematics, & language development





Goal: Implement a statewide approach to improving LEA capacity by collaboratively developing, delivering, sharing, and spotlighting practices that have demonstrated the power to improve outcomes for students historically underserved.

Initiative 1

Develop structures for identifying & developing professional learning resources that emphasize high priority topics throughout the school year to build COE/LEA capacity to implement Local Control Accountability Plans (LCAP) goals to improve outcomes for students historically underserved.



Initiative 2

Design and implement strategy and initiatives to share lessons learned from our work and emerging/best practices from the field to support sustained improvement for students

Develop high quality, relevant, and usable data tools, guidance, and evidence-based resources to support LEA decision-making that leads to improved student outcomes

Initiative 3

Collect and analyze internal program and statewide data to measure student outcomes and impact of instructional supports



Analyze systematically collected data to understand the impact of statewide programs, supports and professional learning and refine program activities to better focus on improving student outcomes

Initiative 1

Facilitate the realization of a shared vision for implementation of the Statewide System of Support (SSOS) that develops coordinated actions resulting in equitable educational outcomes as defined in the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) goals for students historically underserved.

Develop and align coordinated, collaborative and integrated structures across lead agencies such as County Offices of Education, Geographic Leads, and SELPA Leads to address LEA universal, targeted and intensive supports

Initiative 2

Identify and distribute promising practices that build innovation, collaboration, and impact across the state

Convene, gather, and equip SSOS leads around best practices that address and target equitable educational outcomes for ALL students

Initiative 3

Partner with County Offices of Education (COEs) to enhance a coherent statewide system of support that coordinates, collaborates and integrates resources and strategies to improve educational outcomes for all students

Build the capacity of lead agencies such as County Offices of Education, Geographic Leads, and SELPA Leads for measuring statewide impact of student learning efforts

Retain staff through uses of staff engagement opportunities and evaluations to identify and determine CCEE learning successes, challenges, and necessary organizational changes




