21CSLA UTK LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE

Earn Your Universal Transitional Kindergarten Leadership Certificate

ABOUT Led by 21CSLA in partnership with the CDE, State Board of Education, California Collaborative for Educational Excellence, and UC Berkeley Extension, the Universal Transitional Kindergarten (UTK) Leadership Certificate prepares leaders to “lead for equity” in the implementation of UTK in California.

ELIGIBILITY Participants must be currently enrolled in a CTC-approved program granting a Preliminary or Clear Administrative Services Credential (PASC or CASC).

STRUCTURE The two-course, four-unit program is offered live online through UC Berkeley Extension and taught by UTK leaders in the field. Each two-unit course is 30 hours across 10 sessions of instruction.

COST A grant from the CDE allows this certificate program to be offered at no cost through June 2026.

The Program*

Course 1: Leaders Designing Equitable Transitional Kindergarten Classrooms in Action

OFFERED FALL 2023

SECTION 1 THURSDAYS, SEPTEMBER 7–NOVEMBER 9, 2023, 5:00–8:00 PM

SECTION 2 TUESDAYS, SEPTEMBER 12–NOVEMBER 14, 2023, 5:00–8:00 PM

Instructional leadership focusing on equity-centered preschool through third grade (P–3) public education. Topics include education policy, integration of UTK into K–12 systems, family and community partnership, and inclusive school programs.

Course 2: Equity-Centered Leadership Practices to Support, Integrate, and Align Transitional Kindergarten

OFFERED SPRING 2024

Instructional leadership focusing on equity-centered P–3 public education. Topics include developing and enacting a P–3 vision, aligning and integrating UTK into the CA educational system, and implementing strategies to build professional capacity through a culture of continuous improvement.

*Program courses may be taken individually or in any order; however, both must be completed for certification.

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
