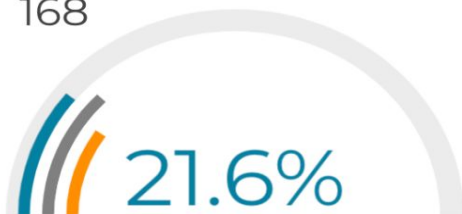

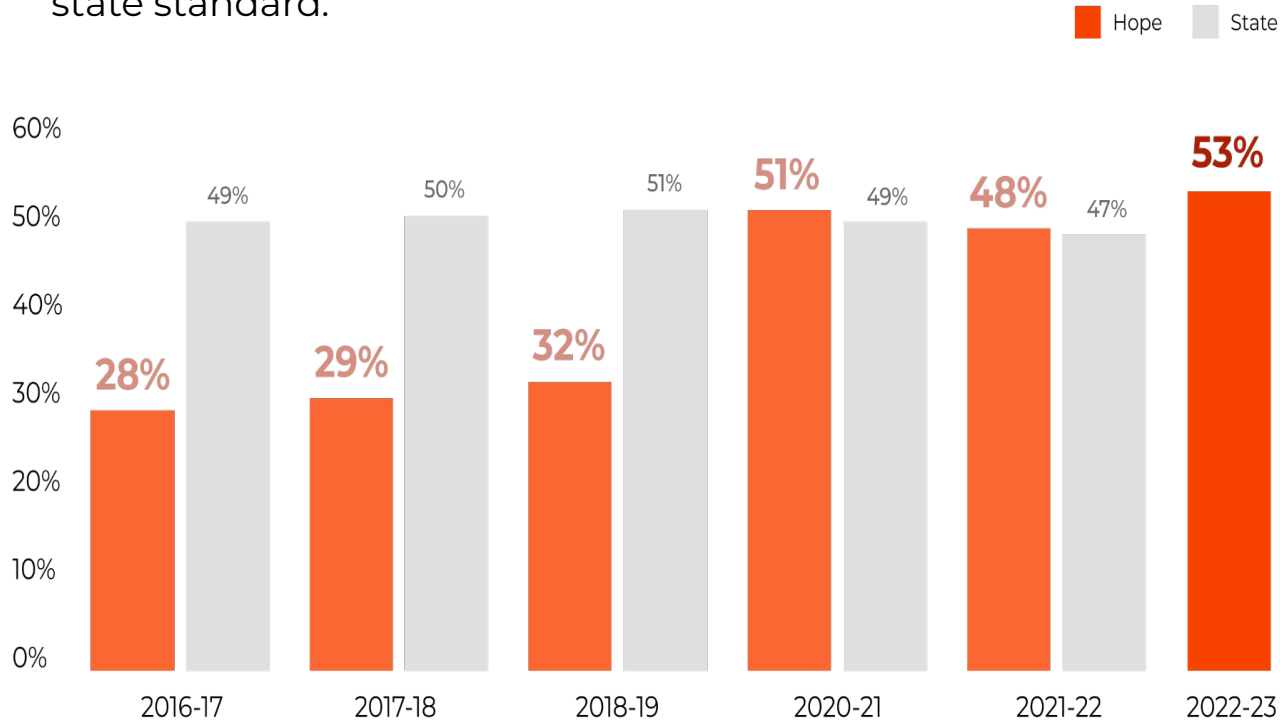

Percent of students who met or exceeded the state standard.

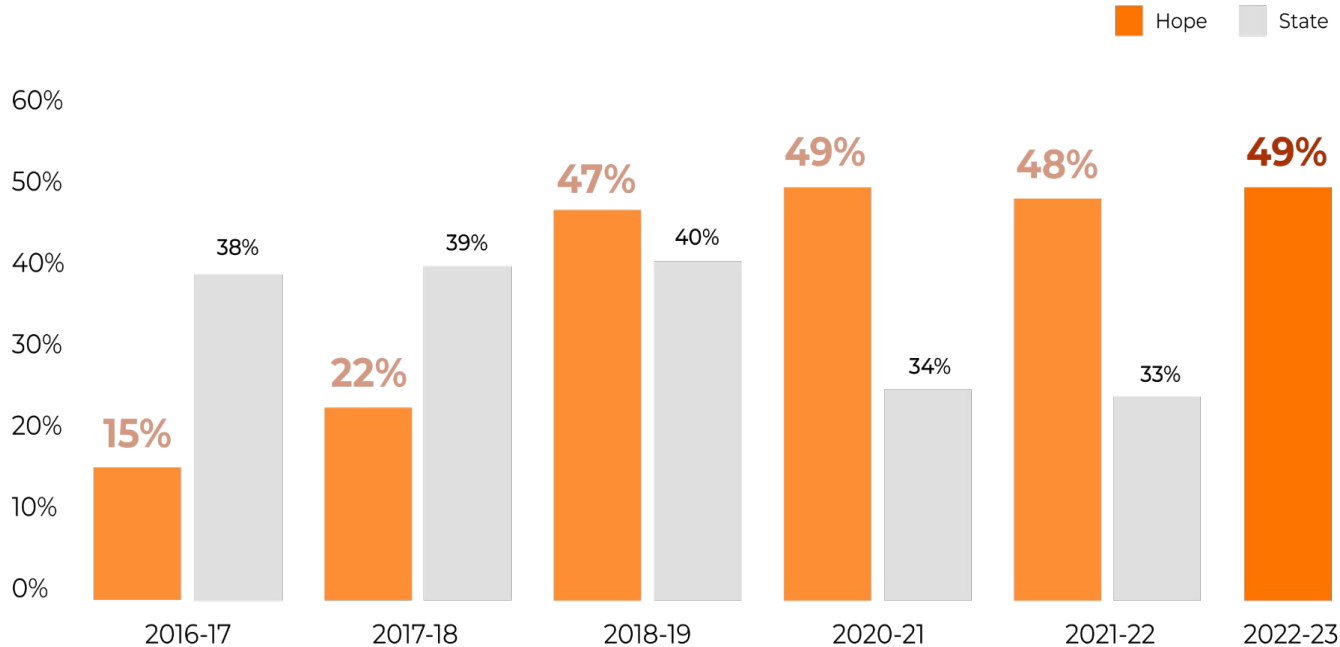

Percent of students who met or exceeded the state standard.

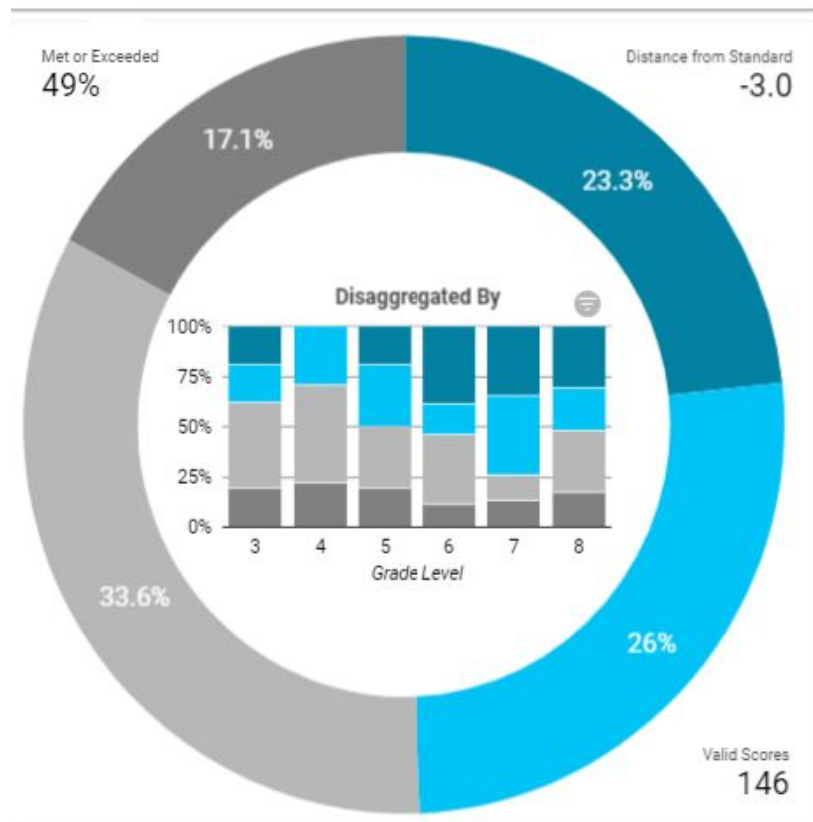
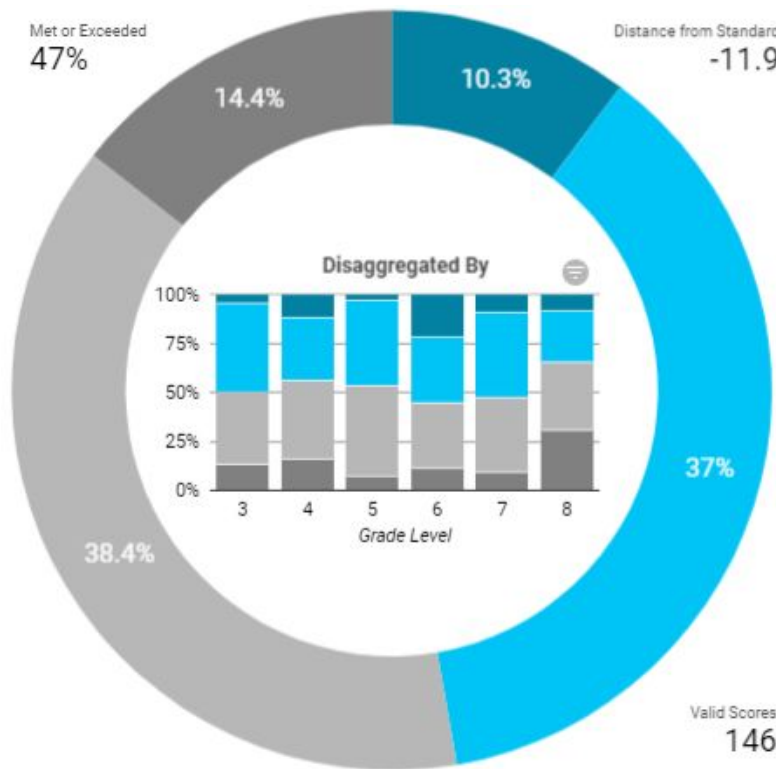
