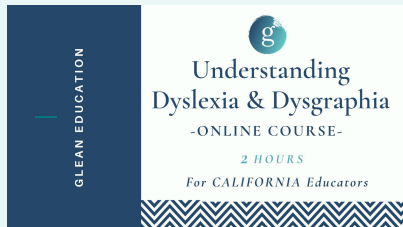

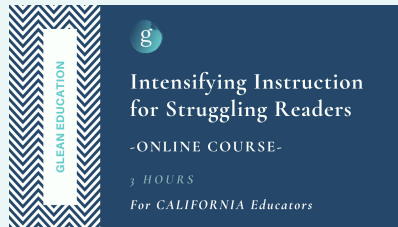

## Courses Offered by Glean Education



### Understanding Dyslexia & Dysgraphia for California Educators 2 Hours

This course will build educator knowledge to understand, identify, and support students with dyslexia in their classroom.



### Intensifying Instruction for Struggling Readers for California Educators 3 Hours

This course will build educator knowledge in intensifying instruction to support struggling readers within an MTSS framework.



### Serving Students with Dyslexia for California School Psychologists 5 Hours

This course will build knowledge for School Psychologists, School Leaders, and Special Education teachers on understanding how to collaborate as parts of a data team and support students with dyslexia and dysgraphia through the evaluation process for special education eligibility.
