Statewide System of Support Directory

Levers for System Change

The Levers for System Change tool is designed for LEAs to assess the quality of their educational infrastructure in order to improve outcomes for ALL students, inclusive of serving students with disabilities. LEA teams evaluate, document, and progress monitor the status of implementation of the six fundamental components necessary for a successful LEA.



BASIC Infrastructure Assessment Tool

The BASIC Infrastructure Assessment Tool, or the "Basics", was developed through a partnership with the California Department of Education, CCEE, and WestEd. The tool is a self-assessment which assists LEAs in identifying strengths and areas for improvement utilizing six basic, or foundational, components for the kind of infrastructure needed in order to have a well-functioning special education program.

The Community Engagement Learning Modules offer a series of in-depth trainings on meaningful pupil, family, and community engagement that are scaffolded to support the continued professional development and deeper expertise of educators. Some of the focus areas include but are not limited to, progress monitoring and evaluation, enhancing engagement for LCAP design, engaging the community from the roots up, and collaborative leadership structures.

In collaboration with the Santa Clara County Office of Education, CCEE developed a technical assistance tool to generate uniquely tailored blending, braiding, and layering options for every LEA to determine how best to support their UPK programs. There is also a Resource Library with curated resources specific to blending, braiding, and layering funding for UPK programs.



[CCEE 2023 Differentiated Assistance \(DA\) Dashboard¹](#)

The DA Dashboard is a tool created for Geographic Leads, County Offices of Education, and District Leaders to engage in their continuous improvement work to improve student outcomes. Utilizing data from the CA School Dashboard and Differentiated Assistance Eligibility lists, the data can be sorted by State, Geographic Lead, County and LEAs (Districts, Charter Schools and County Offices of Education). It also provides information on trends over time and eligibility for ATSI and CSI all in one place.



[CCEE 2023 Students with Disabilities \(SWD\) Data Tool²](#)

The SWD Dashboard is a tool created for Geographic Leads, County Offices of Education, SELPAs, and District Leaders. Utilizing data from the CA Dashboard and Special Education LEA Annual Performance Reports (APRs), it provides a satellite data view all in one place for students with disabilities. Differentiated Assistance (DA) eligibility for students with disabilities and Compliance Improvement Monitoring (CIM) status are provided to better align and leverage these two systems.
