

Direct Technical Assistance Charter Pathways



There are various pathways in which a charter school may be eligible to receive CCEE support via Direct Technical Assistance. In all pathways, CCEE has the discretion to accept the referral request.



Pathway 1: County Superintendent Recommendation

The Charter School* is referred for CCEE support by the County Superintendent (and with the approval of the Geographic Lead agency) after the county has provided technical assistance.

Pathway 2: County Superintendent Request

Based on the Charter School's** eligibility, it is directly referred by the County Superintendent for CCEE assistance after the State Superintendent is consulted and the State Board of Education approves.

Pathway 3: State Superintendent Referral

The Charter School is referred directly by the State Superintendent for advice and assistance in accomplishing the goals set forth in the school's Local Control and Accountability Plan.

Pathway 4: County Superintendent Consultation

The Charter School receives assistance from CCEE as a technical assistance provider in consultation with the County Superintendent.*
Ed. Code 47607.3(a)

* Charter must have 1 or more student groups not meeting two local or state priorities in 2 or more years as identified on the CA Dashboard.

** Charter must have 3 or more student groups not meeting two or more LCFF Priorities for 3 out of 4 consecutive years as identified on the CA Dashboard.
