COLLABORATIVE PLANNING EFFORTS

Within the Direct Technical Assistance (DTA) **Spectrum of Support**, at the Collaborative Planning level, CCEE's role is as a coach and thought partner with County and District teams connecting them to resources and engaging in reflective practices to highlight impact and growth areas.



Out of 54 districts, 42 across 21 Counties are engaging with **CCEE's Collaborative Planning level of support** within DTA.

MINDSET SHIFTS





IMPACT OF DA/DTA SUPPORTS ON STUDENTS

40% of Collaborative Planning Districts that still qualify for DTA **decreased** the number of student groups that are DTA-Eligible

In light of various DTA districts experiencing Superintendent turnover, CCEE will continue to **provide leadership development opportunities and promote coherence** within district leadership teams.

We are also seeing the theme of SWDs being a critical student group and growing by **establishing a SWD Network Improvement Community**.



CCEE NEXT STEPS

CCEE is currently meeting with COEs to discuss 15 newly identified DTA districts and to continue conversations on how to support DTA districts that remain eligible for DTA.

As of December 2024, since the latest dashboard release, **15 DTA districts are no longer eligible** for DTA.
