Attendance Matters at Jefferson

Jefferson Families,

We are beginning the 5th week of the school year and student attendance is very important. Help your child succeed in school by building the habit of good attendance.

Did you know...

- Starting in TK and kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10% or about 2 days each month over the course of a school year, can make it harder to learn to read.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just 1 or 2 days every few weeks.
- Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.
- Absences and tardiness can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.

Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school and themselves. Start building this habit in TK so they will learn right away that going to school on time, every day is important. Eventually, good attendance will be a skill that will help them succeed in high school and college.

What you can do...

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Develop backup plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, a neighbor, or another parent.

At Jefferson students with Perfect Attendance for the trimester will be recognized at our Terrific Kid assembly. Students with Perfect Attendance for the school year will receive a medal and will be put into a drawing for a bike at the end of the school year assembly. Students must not have more than 3 tardies in order to qualify for Perfect Attendance.

Students with excessive tardies (more than 3 days arriving after 8:00 a.m.) will have to make up the time during morning recess in our Responsibility Room.

Parents, please make sure your child attends school daily and arrives on time. If an issue should arise, please contact Ms. Sanchez or Mrs. Rosalez at 305-7230.

Help Your Child Succeed in Preschool and Kindergarten Build the Habit of Good Attendance

DID YOU KNOW...

Showing up on time every day is important to your child's success and learning from preschool forward.

Missing 10% of school (1 or 2 days every few weeks) can make it harder to:

- Gain early reading and math skills.
- Build relationships.
- Develop good attendance habits.

High quality preschool and kindergarten has many benefits!

- The routines your child develops will continue throughout school.
- Make the most of early grades by encouraging your child to attend every day.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

Work with your child and his/her teacher to develop your child's strong attendance.

Talk about it - sing about it - make it an adventure!

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Share ideas with other parents for getting to school on time.

Before the school year starts:

- Find out what day school starts and begin a countdown!
- Keep your child healthy and make sure your child has the required shots.
- Attend orientation with your child to meet teachers and classmates and find out about health and safety procedures.

Ready, Set, GO!

- If you are concerned your child may have Covid-19, call your school for advice. Ask for resources to continue learning at home if needed.
- Ask family members or neighbors for assistance if you need help.
- Try to schedule non-urgent medical appointments and extended trips when school is not in session.
- If your child seems anxious about preschool or kindergarten, talk to the program director, teacher, your doctor or other parents for advice.
