**Learning Network** participants focus on student impact goals

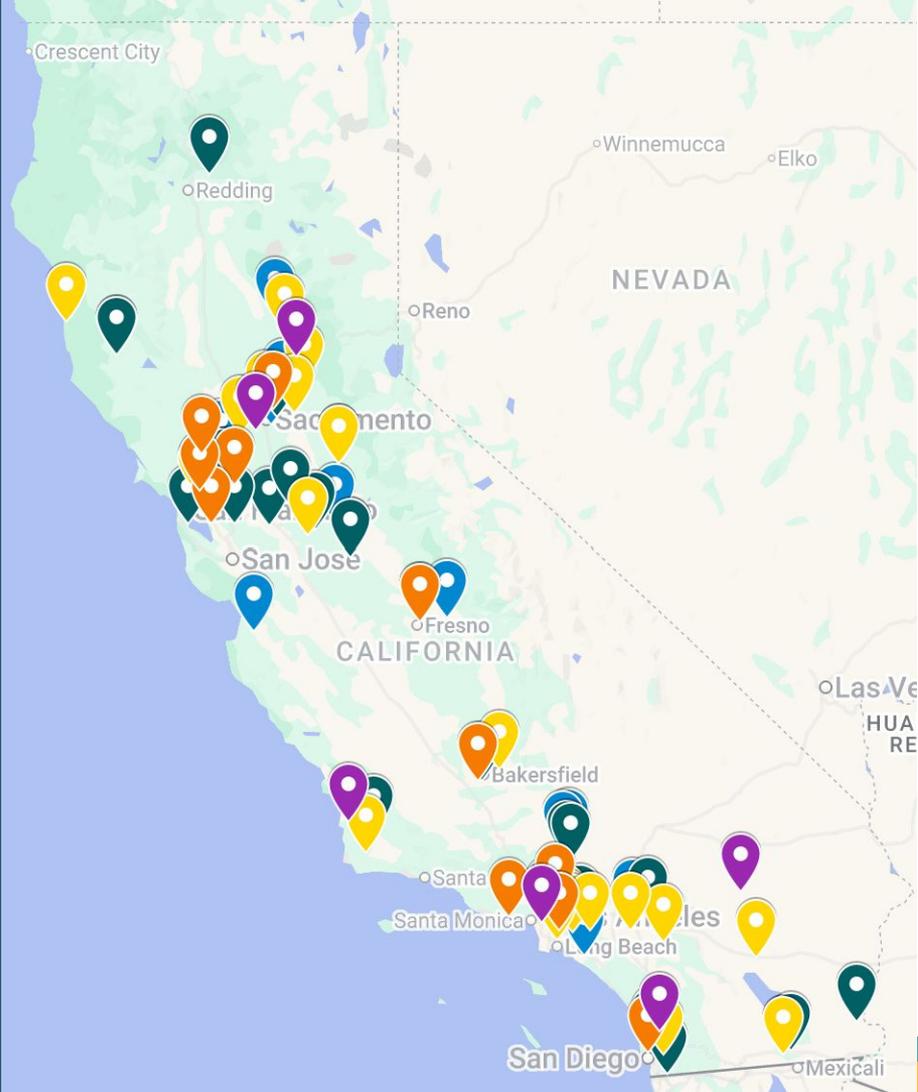
- UDL Implementation: classroom instruction

**13 Learning Networks and Data Academy** provide high-leverage capacity building supports through ongoing, practice-based learning



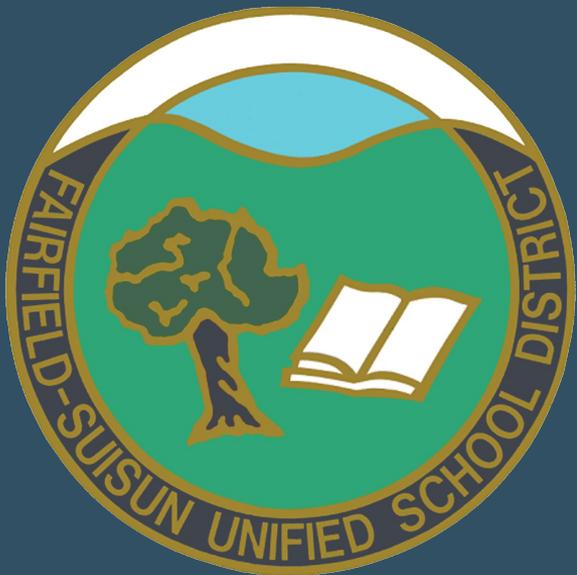
Impact is strengthened when **learning connects to implementation** through coordinated supports across CCEE, including Direct Technical Assistance

- **2017-18:** FSUSD first qualified for Differentiated Assistance and received support from the Solano County Office of Education
  - Special Education
  - Chronic Absenteeism
  - CSI Schools
- **2024-25:** FSUSD continued to qualify for Differentiated Assistance and the support expanded to include CCEE
  - Priority 4: Pupil Achievement
  - Priority 5: Student Engagement
  - Priority 6: School Climate
  - Priority 7: Outcomes in a Broad Course of Study
